Bejahte Aussage (positive sentence)	Verneinte Aussage (negative sentence)	Fragesatz (question)
I like ice cream.	I don't like ice cream.	Do I like ice cream?
Natalie speaks English.	Natalie doesn't speak English.	Does Natalie speak English?

you	speak	you	don't speak	Do	you	speak
they	speak	they	don't speak	Do	they	speak
